TOURNAMENT FORMAT

TEAM NET STABLEFORD

Teammates will accumulate Stableford points based on their individual net scores. The highest combined point total will determine the winners.

- NET Bogey = 2 Points
- NET Par = 3 Points
- NET Birdie = 5 Points
- NET Eagle = 8 Points
- NET Double Eagle = 12 Points

Players must not exceed a handicap spread greater than 10. If two players have a higher spread, the higher handicap player will be reduced until the spread of 10 is met. If Player A has a course handicap of 10 and Player B has a course handicap of 22, Player B will be reduced to a course handicap of 20.

Each player will receive one miracle putt per round.

We will flight the competition into four flights after the first round of competition based on the combined Team Stableford score.

In the event of rain, the completed round will stand for the competition. If a round is completely rained out, gift certificates will be issued for a round of golf. No refunds will be given.

LADIES GOLF ASSOCIATION LOCAL RULES

Play is governed by the 2023 Rules of Golf and where applicable by the following Local Rules. Unless otherwise specified, penalty for breach of a Local Rule is two strokes in Stroke Play.

DROP ZONE FOR WATER HAZARD & NATIVE AREAS

HOLE 6

If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain a ball that has not been found is in the water hazard, the player may proceed under Rule 26-1 or as an additional option, under penalty of one stroke, drop a ball on the drop zone.

HOLE 18

No. 18 will have a drop zone for players to use. The drop zone may be used if a player hits their golf ball into the canyon on their third shot or more. If a player attempts to go for the green in two and hits it in the penalty area, the player must drop the golf ball on the fairway size of the penalty area.

TEMPORARY IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

All fan and grow lights are to be played as TIOs. Nearest relief is granted no nearer to the hole from stance, swing and line of play. One club length, no closer to the hole.

LOCAL RULE REGARDING LOST BALL & OUT OF BOUNDS

When a player's ball cannot be found or comes to rest out of bounds, it will be playing as a red penalty area. For ONE penalty stroke, the player may take relief by dropping the original ball or a substituted ball in a relief area determined by two points:

- 1.** Take lateral relief within two club lengths of where your ball last crossed into the penalty area.
- 2.** You can play from where your last stroke was made (stroke and distance).

The relief area extends two club lengths on either side of those points on a line straight back in line with the flag. The relief area will make a pie shape no closer to the hole than the estimated ball reference point. You may drop anywhere within the relief area.



LADIES GOLF ASSOCIATION LOCAL RULES

MULCH PATHS & ROCKS BORDERING MULCH PATHS

All mulch paths are deemed to be integral parts of the golf course. If a ball comes to rest on or near a mulch path, the golf ball must be played as it lies. No relief from the mulch or areas near the mulch will be given. All rocks that border or provide containment for the mulch paths are deemed to be immovable obstructions. One club length of free relief from nearest relief no closer to the hole.

OBSTRUCTIONS NEAR THE PUTTING GREEN

If a ball lies in the general area and an immovable obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green and within two club lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief no closer to the hole, one club length from the nearest point of relief.

CART PATH RELIEF

Relief from cart paths/hard surfaces will be given at the nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole. In some cases, this relief will be in an unmaintained native area. If a player elects to take relief, they must drop within one club length.

OUT OF BOUNDS

The inside edge of the cart path on No. 9 is the out of bounds line. A ball on or left of the cart path is deemed out of bounds. If any part of the ball is inbounds, the ball is deemed inbounds and relief from the path will be granted no closer to the hole.

No. 15 fairway is out of bounds when playing on No. 16.

Hole No. 5 Marking Change & Relief

The hazard will run along the creek all the way through the hole continuing through 6A. If your ball comes to rest on the cart path left of the green, you will get full relief nearest point, no closer to the hole. If a player elects to take relief, they must take full relief from the surface by finding their nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole, and drop within one club length.

In case of a rules question, please play a second ball and the Rules Committee will make a decision following play.
