GOLF RULES

- Proper golf etiquette is expected at all times. Fix ball marks, leave the course better than you found it, and do not negatively impact any other member's experience.
- Dress code: Members and their guests are expected to wear attire appropriate for a private golf club. Traditional golf shirts, slacks, skirts, and shorts are acceptable. Men's golf shirts must have a collar and must be tucked in. Hats must be forward-facing at all times. Cargo-style shorts and jeans of any kind are not permitted. Women may wear collarless golf-style shirts provided they have sleeves and may wear sleeveless golf shirts provided they have a collar. All skirts and shorts should be of respectable length. No blue jeans or denim may be worn on the golf course. No metal spikes are allowed.
- All golf guests must be registered with Golf Shop prior to playing golf or using practice areas.
- Keep up with the group in front of you. If you fall behind, pick up the pace. If you cannot keep pace with the group in front of you, let the group behind you play through, irrespective of the number of players in that group. A slow group is defined as any group that takes more than 4 hours 20 minutes to complete an 18-hole round.
- Rake all bunkers properly. Place the rake in the bunker toward the center of the bunker and place the black handle of the rake on the edge of the bunker.
- Please properly repair all ball marks on every green.
- Cutting in immediately in front of any group on any hole is prohibited.
- Littering of any kind will not be tolerated.
- Players may start from the 10th tee ONLY with specific permission from the Golf Shop staff. Groups starting from the 10th tee will not have priority on the 1st tee after making the turn.
- Remove used or broken tees from the teeing surface. All divots should be filled with the sand that is provided on your cart. Properly repair ball marks using a pronged repair tool (provided in the Golf Shop or on the first tee) to move healthy turf inward to the center of the impacted area. Once this is completed, use the bottom of your putter to lightly tap the surface smooth.
- Any person operating a golf cart must have a valid driver's license and operate the cart safely and responsibly at all times. No more than two adults may ride in a single cart. No standing on the cart while it is in motion. A single cart may carry no more than two bags.


